



REOPENING REPORT

In-person/Hybrid Instruction

Thanks to the work of our staff and community we have devised our In-person/Hybrid Model for Reopening for the 2020-2021 school year. It is based on guidance from the State Department of Health and State Education Department and is subject to New York State approval. This model looks to maximize in-person instruction while protecting student and staff health. Fridays will provide the opportunity to prepare and deliver ongoing remote learning experiences for students. With all students learning remotely on Fridays, the district will be able to deep clean and sanitize the classrooms and buildings as well. Grades 7-12 will phase in attendance by grade level to start the school year. Grades K-6 will all begin classes together on the first day of school.

Friday is for remote learning. Teachers will provide work in a variety of ways for students to complete independently.

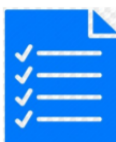

Full-time Remote Learning—Students participate in learning via technology while in the home environment. Instruction is provided by a teacher in the Hammondsport CSD.
