

## **Nomination Criteria**

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENT is open to former students who have attended (a) Hammond sport school(s) who have performed significant, out-of-the-ordinary athletic accomplishments beyond high school; have contributed on the well-being of their communities; reached 25 years of age.

Student Athlete:

1. Graduate of Hammond sport
2. Outstanding high School Athlete
3. Has demonstrated outstanding athletic achievement as a player or Coach at the high school and/or collegiate level or beyond.

Athletic Coach:

1. Employed by Hammond sport as a coach.
2. Has an outstanding high school career record.
3. A coach that the student athletes look up to as a role model.

Athletic Team:

1. A team that was outstanding in sectional and/or state competition
2. A team that was respected by the community, county and section.

It will be the responsibility of the person submitting the application to provide statistics, records, achievements and other pertinent information of the person or team being nominated.

There will be a waiting period after high school of a minimum of five years or age 25 for athletes.

GOLD STAR is for former students who have attended a Hammond sport school(s) who were killed in the line of duty in the armed forces of the United State. Gold Star names will be added as they are verified.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT is open to former students who have attended a Hammond sport school(s) and who have performed significant, out-of-the-ordinary accomplishments in the world at large; have contributed to the well-being of their communities; and have reached 40 years of age.
